YEAGER AIRPORT AND THE KANAWHA COUNTY COMMISSION WANT YOU TO HELP YOU AVOID THE FLU

The Kanawha County Commission has provided travel compliant hand sanitizer for passengers traveling through Yeager Airport this flu season. Please take one as you pass through security.

State health officials say flu activity in West Virginia has increased overall for the sixth consecutive week.

Free flu shots for Kanawha County residents are also available through “Project Last Shot,” a partnership between the Kanawha County Commission and the Kanawha-Charleston Health Department. Stations will be set up throughout the county until all 4,000 shots are provided.

Also supporting Project Last Shot are the City of Charleston, Kanawha County Ambulance Authority, Kanawha Valley Regional Transportation Authority and Kanawha County Schools.

“Yeager Airport appreciates the support from the Kanawha County Commission in trying to keep our customers and staff safe from the flu,” reports Yeager Airport Director, Terry Sayre.
