CAPITAL JET CENTER AT YEAGER AIRPORT APPROVED TO HANDLE INTERNATIONAL REGULATED GARBAGE

As of February 2019, Capital Jet Center, the Fixed Base Operator (FBO) at Yeager Airport (CRW), has been approved to handle International Regulated Garbage from arriving general aviation flights requiring this service. This generally includes all arrivals from foreign regions.

Capital Jet Center is a U.S. Customs Port of Entry, and Yeager Airport may now accept international general aviation flights carrying regulated garbage. This greatly expands the ability to offer international service beyond inbound international travel from Canada.

In accordance with Title 7 Code of Federal Regulations 330.400-330.403 and Title 9 Code of Federal Regulations 94.5 regulated garbage is not allowed to be imported, except from Canada. Regulated garbage arriving on means of conveyances from foreign regions, other than Canada, is only allowed entry under certain conditions. Regulated garbage is defined as “all waste material that is derived in whole or in part from fruits, vegetables, meats, or other plant or animal (including poultry) material, and other refuse or any character whatsoever that has been associated with any such material.”

Capital Jet Center handled their first international garbage disposal on February 28th, 2019 from a nonstop flight from Prague, Czech Republic.
