SEVERE WEATHER AT YEAGER AIRPORT

Yeager Airport (CRW) saw severe weather Monday evening. The Airport terminal building and the Capital Jet Center are currently operating on back-up generators.

Travelers should check with their airlines before traveling to the Airport.

Passengers that were awaiting flights during the weather event sheltered in place pursuant to the Airport's Emergency Plan. "Yeager Airport Police and Operations staff responded quickly to keep everyone safe," said Airport Director, Terry Sayre.

Those traveling to Yeager Airport for evening flights should allow for extra drive-time to reach the Airport, as many roads are currently blocked by downed trees—including Keystone Drive.
