NIGHT CONSTRUCTION STOPPING BECAUSE OF NOISE

Due to noise complaints from surrounding neighbors, the airport is stopping night time construction of a slip repair on the North side of the runway. The repairs are going to be done during the day.

“We want to be a good neighbor,” said Yeager Airport Director, Nick Keller. “We listened to the community, and are moving our construction plan in a new direction.”

The repairs are going to be done in between scheduled commercial flights. To stay in compliance with the FAA, the airport is issuing a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM). The runway will be shutdown during scheduled, day-time hours. The only exception is for military, emergency, and helicopter landings.

“This gives the construction crew two to three hour windows to get work done,” Keller added. “We think this the best solution to get the work done in a safe and timely manner.”

Due to the short time windows contractors have, all of the scheduled closure times are going to be strictly enforced.
