YEAGER AIRPORT STEPPING UP SECURITY

Yeager Airport is adding extra security measures after a U.S. airstrike killed Iran's top general. There is no threat to Charleston or Yeager Airport right now, this is being done out of an abundance of caution.

"We want everyone to know we are taking this extremely serious," said Yeager Airport Police Chief Eric Johnson.

In addition to Yeager Police, the Charleston Police Department, Kanawha County Sheriff's Department and the West Virginia State Police are going to have units making rounds at the airport.

"We don't want to worry anyone when they see more officers than normal at the airport. Again, we just want to be on top of things, and keep our public safe," Johnson stressed.

Yeager Airport is also going to strictly enforce no parking curbside of the terminal in the drop off lane. If you leave a vehicle unattended there, it will be towed.
