YEAGER AIRPORT RECEIVES \$4.8 MILLION UNDER CARES ACT

Charleston's Yeager Airport (CRW) will receive \$4.8 million under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (the CARES Act).

"We would like to thank Senators Capito and Manchin, Congressman Mooney and Congresswoman Miller for their advocacy in Washington, D.C., and their ongoing support of airports during this crisis," said Airport Director, Nick Keller.

The funds will be administered by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The FAA's primary concern is that federally obligated airports remain safe and open to the traveling public and aircraft. Particularly, during this public health emergency, airports play an essential role in transporting medical and emergency equipment and personnel. CARES Act funds will allow airports to operate safely and stay open during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Yeager Airport is an essential service provider to the community, providing air transportation services for essential passengers, air cargo and mail, medical, law enforcement, and the United States military.
