## CONSTRUCTION UNDERWAY TO REPAIR AIRPORT ROAD SLIP

The West Virginia Division of Highways (WVDOH) has started repairs to the slip along Airport Road, the single access road to Yeager Airport (CRW). WVDOH will be putting soil nails in the ground to stabilize the slip. In addition, Yeager Airport removed any trees that could affect power lines or nearby homes on Keystone Road.

“As soon as we learned about the slip, we got in touch with the WVDOH and Moss Tree Service,” said Yeager Airport Director Nick Keller. “We got things in motion as quickly as possible to save the road, and property on Keystone Drive.”

While construction is ongoing, Airport Road is down to one lane. Temporary stoplights have been put up by the WVDOH to keep traffic moving smoothly. However, if you are coming to Yeager Airport, please allow extra time to get to the terminal.

“This has been a team effort, and I’m thankful how quickly a plan was put into motion,” stressed Keller. “I’d like to thank the Kanawha County Commission, the WVDOH, Governor Justice, Secretary of Transportation Byrd White, as well as Moss Tree Service.”
